


Gallery 1819 Singapore is a Fine Art gallery that features Southeast Asian artworks from artists across the international region.

Under her childhood mentor Mr Yap Tay Soon, she learned various Western art forms such as pencil sketch, charcoal drawing, watercolour, acrylic and oil painting.

Alicia started her career as a graphic designer after graduating from Temasek Polytechnic. Currently, she is a full-time art educator. In 2016, she started taking watercolour lessons from Singapore Master Ong Kim Seng. In 2018, she participated in "Mr Ong Kim Seng and Student Watercolour Exhibition" featuring plein air paintings done in their Tibet trip.

Her recent art achievements include Excellent Award for the International Masters of Watercolour Alliance (IMWA) 2022, UK SAA Artists of the Year 2021. Finalist for 2nd Annual Women in Watercolour International Juried Competition, and First prize for Fremantle 2020 Plein Air competition.

A Member of Singapore Watercolour Society since 2018, Alicia is currently serving as Treasurer (2021 to present). She is also part of SWS Jury of Judges (2021 to present).

Since relocating to Hong Kong, she has been obsessed with recording this city that is bursting with contrast at almost every turn - grit and glam, chaos and calm, spending every available weekend sketching and painting plein-air.

Lisa held her 1st solo-exhibition in May 2016 and participated other group exhibitions such as Affordable Art Fair and Young Art Taipei, her works have been collected in Asia and Europe. Born in Singapore with a professional background in interior architecture design, Lisa is a self-taught artist in oil, watercolor painting and print-making. Honing experience from 20 years of design work, she applies her deft sense of perspective drawings, sensitivity to textures and juxtaposition of colors coupled with an unorthodox, undeterred approach to her paintings. Painted mainly outdoors, these works suggest the broad field of vision, energy, movement and life one experiences only when outdoors.
